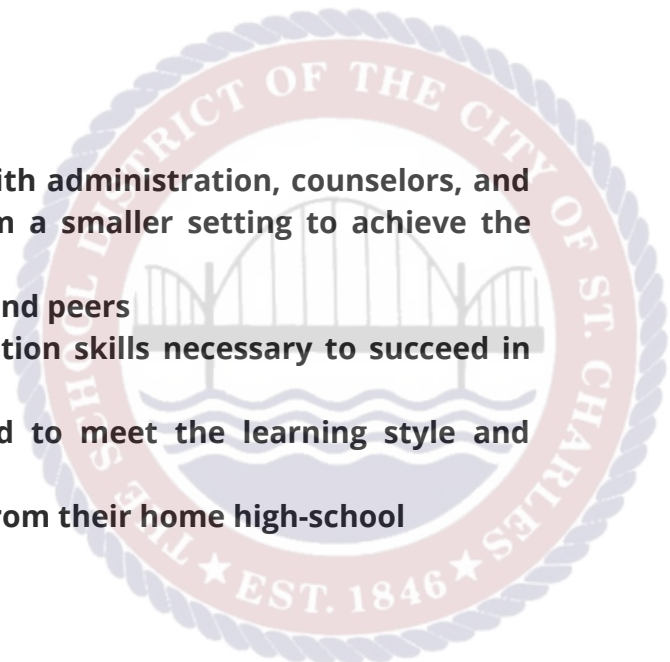


Youth Experiencing Success

Youth Experiencing Success (YES)

Students are selected through collaboration with administration, counselors, and families to identify students who benefit from a smaller setting to achieve the following goals:

- Foster respectful relationships with adults and peers
- Develop responsible social and communication skills necessary to succeed in life
- Receive individualized instruction designed to meet the learning style and social-emotional needs of the student
- Earn credits toward a high-school diploma from their home high-school



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Missouri Options Program

Missouri Options Program (MO-OPS)

The Missouri Option Program is designed to provide an option for students who are behind their cohort group in the credits needed to graduate or for other significant reasons identified are unable to complete their diploma with their cohort group (class). Students can opt out of the high school credit system and earn their diploma by meeting the following criteria:

- **Successful completion of Health, Personal Finance and Government, MO and US Constitution tests and Civics test.**
- **Complete the necessary hours to be a full-time student through a combination of the following.**
 - Educational time in the classroom
 - Work hours
 - Volunteer hours
- **Pass 5 Missouri HSET tests in the following subjects:**
 - Reading
 - Writing
 - Math
 - Social Studies
 - Science



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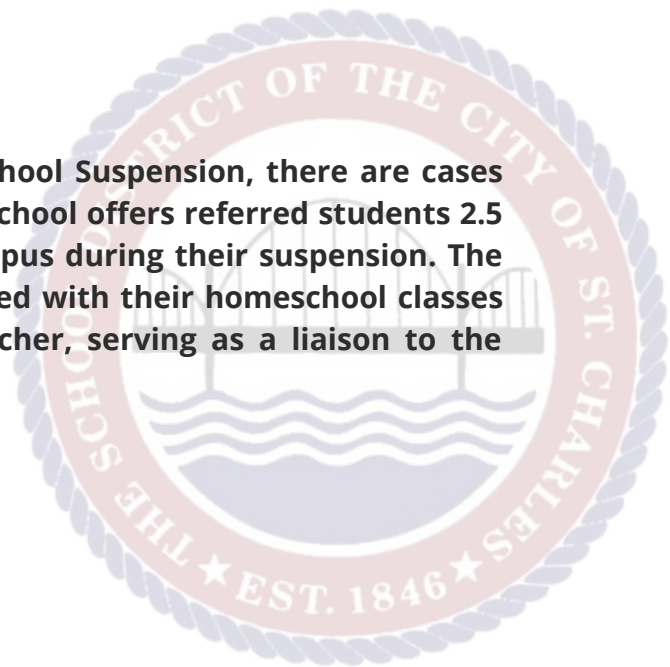
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Re-Entry School

Re-Entry School (RES)

If students receive an extension of an Out of School Suspension, there are cases when they qualify for Re-Entry School. Re-Entry School offers referred students 2.5 hours of instruction, on site, at the Success Campus during their suspension. The goal of the program is to keep students connected with their homeschool classes at the Success Campus, through a certified teacher, serving as a liaison to the home school.

Juvenile Justice Center Education (JJC)

Suppose a student commits a crime and is relocated to the Juvenile Justice Center. In that case, the Success Campus provides two teachers to provide students with full-day educational support throughout the student's stay at the Juvenile Justice Center. Teachers collaborate with school counselors from the homeschooled students, which are served all throughout St. Charles County.
