*Our last day of virtual instruction is Thursday, May 21st. Report cards will be emailed in early June.

*Soon, principals will be emailing out specific information regarding plans for student pick up and drop off of personal/school items at individual school buildings. This will occur during May 26-29. Please adhere to all directives and guidelines set by your principal. Please note that this isn't a time for congregating or visiting. Social distancing (6ft) will need to be followed. Wearing a mask is certainly an appropriate choice and encouraged, but not mandatory. Principals are planning to get students/parents in and out of the property/building in the safest/quickest manner possible. Due to a flooring project, the Early Childhood days for pick up will be Tuesday, June 30 & Wednesday, July 1. Elementary parents, please complete the Chromebook return form so we know when you plan to return the borrowed Chromebook. The District will be providing an extension for students to keep Chromebooks throughout the summer until the end of July. This opportunity is being offered so that students can participate in virtual learning activities. PreK-8 summer learning activities will be available on the District's website beginning no later than June 15.
