- Access counselor recommendations on additional support for their student.


Naviance Student also lets us share information with you and your student about upcoming meetings and events, local scholarship opportunities, and other resources for college and career information.


1. Use an Internet browser to connect to: <https://student.naviance.com/schsch>




Once an account is set up, log in and select the student you wish to view. This will take you to the homepage.



# Home Page Navigation


Parents may change the language by selecting the globe icon in the upper right hand corner and selecting their preferred language.

# Benefits of Naviance for Parents

- Parent accounts in Naviance allow parents to see what their students have been doing in Naviance.
- In most cases, parents don't have the ability to edit in Naviance.
- Parents can see information including:
  - Results from self-discovery assessments their students have completed
  - Favorite colleges, scholarships, careers, and career clusters
  - Tasks assigned to their student and the completion status of those tasks
  - Resources and information from the school, such as links/pages, work-based learning events, and scholarship opportunities

## Self-Discovery

- Parents can easily see which assessments their students have completed and view the results for any completed assessments
- Parents cannot take assessments on behalf of their students
